

WRIGHT TOWNSHIP REGULAR BOARD MEETING
APRIL 14, 2010
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The following minutes were taken at the April, 2010 board meeting and are currently approved.

1. The regular board meeting was called to order by Supervisor Becker at 7:30 P.M. with the Pledge and a prayer. Board members present were JoAnn Becker, Rick Schoenborn, Linda Way, Tracy Worrell and Josh Westgate.
2. One addition to the agenda – Wright Tavern will become Item #9 and others renumbered.
3. A motion was made by Westgate and supported by Worrell to approve the bills in the amount of \$58,473.75 and to accept the treasurer's report, Trust and Agency and Tax Account Profit & Loss. Motion carried. A motion was made by Schoenborn and supported by Westgate to approve the minutes of March 10th Regular, March 10th Special and March 25th Special as written. 4. Brett VanderKamp from Park Twp is running for State Senate. He spoke to the challenges of Michigan and local government. *Attached*
5. A motion was made by Way and supported by Westgate to grant permission to the Marne Lions Club, Marne American Legion and Wright-Tallmadge Fire Department to hold the **62nd Memorial Day Parade on Monday, May 31st at 10 a.m.** The theme will be **Volunteerism**. Motion carried.
6. The Township expresses appreciation to Karen Byrne for her years serving on the Coopersville District Library Board. A motion was made by Schoenborn and supported by Worrell to appoint Carna Brown to the position of library board for the remainder of Byrne's term, which runs to 7/1/2013. Motion carried.
7. PA116 was completed and forwarded to the state.
8. A motion was made by Westgate and supported by Way to adopt Resolution 10-04-01 which is Authorizing Resolution for Michigan Emergency Management Assistance compact. Roll call vote – all ayes. Resolution declared adopted. *Attached*
9. Wright Tavern has requested permission to have an outside One-Day Event on Saturday, May 22 from Noon to Close. A motion was made by Westgate and supported by Way to grant permission and approval contingent upon them having all proper paperwork completed and proper additional permission from other agencies. Motion carried.

10. A motion was made by Way and supported by Worrell to approve \$6,500 toward replacing ceiling tiles, new office furniture for a portion of the space and flooring. Current tiles and flooring are over 30 yrs old and furniture is inadequate for an office setting. Much of the work will be done by Wright Twp Board to save costs. Motion carried. *Attached*

11. Reports were given: 35 Burn Permits; School Election will be May 5th.

12. Congratulations to DeWitt Barrels for maintaining your Michigan Department of Environmental Quality Clean Corporate Citizen designation for the past five years and being recognized as Family-Owned Business of the Year. *Attached*

13. Schoenborn spoke to the concerns of people running the stop sign at Arthur & 16th Avenue. He also discussed spring clean-up in the Marne Cemetery.
