The following minutes were taken at the September, 2011 board meeting and are Approved.

1. The regular board meeting was called to order by Supervisor Becker at 7:30 P.M. with the Pledge and a prayer. Board members present were JoAnn Becker, Linda Way, Tracy Worrell and Josh Westgate. A motion was made by Way and supported by Westgate to approve the absence of Trustee Rich Schoenborn. Motion carried.
2. No additions to the agenda.
3. A motion was made by Westgate and supported by Becker to approve the bills in the amount of \$63,251.68. Motion carried. A motion was made by Westgate and supported by Worrell to approve the minutes with one correction in item 8; the word "lot" will be changed to "parcel". Motion carried.
4. Candidate Amanda VanEssen spoke of her qualifications and reasoning's for running for State Representative of the new 88th District in Ottawa County.
5. Commissioner Greg DeJong spoke of future events and status of various projects.
6. Auditor Jason Mitchell of Hungerford, Aldrin, Carter and Nichols spoke highly of the township's frugal nature and keeping costs in line for several years in a roll.
7. Reports were given.
8. Becker expressed appreciation to the Visser and May families for laying stones and brick on the approach of Cole Park. And to the Visser's for mowing, trimming trees and carving mushrooms out of tree stumps. Also, appreciation to Gary Karr for servicing the air conditioner.
