

**WRIGHT TOWNSHIP REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
DECEMBER 8, 2010

*The following minutes were taken at the December, 2010 board meeting and are currently APPROVED.*

1. The regular board meeting was called to order by Supervisor Becker at 7:30 P.M. with the Pledge and a prayer. Board members present were JoAnn Becker, Rick Schoenborn, Linda Way, Tracy Worrell and Josh Westgate.
2. No additions to the agenda.
3. A motion was made by Westgate and supported by Becker to approve the bills in the amount of \$13,229.31 and to accept the treasurer's report, Trust and Agency and Tax Account Profit & Loss. Motion carried. A motion was made by Westgate and supported by Becker to approve the minutes of November 10, 2010 Regular Board Meeting as written. Motion carried. *Attached*
4. Paul Dykstra, Dykstra Excavating, appeared at the board meeting after being told today to stop hauling & dumping thousands of yards of fill without any permits. Dykstra asked what was required for a permit. He was informed that he needs a Special Land Use from Planning and a permit for land change. Becker stated that she would gather initial application paperwork as well as information from the Zoning Administrator and get to him the following day (Thur.) Dykstra stated that he will continue to haul.
5. Dave Despres spoke to the Board regarding his desire to see a Historical Society in Wright Township. He shared many stores of a very early township. If anyone is interested in hearing his tales, trying to compile his volumes of pictures and printed information, please contact the township. It would be great to compile this information before it is forever gone.
6. A motion was made by Schoenborn and supported by Westgate to reappoint Looks, Molyneux and Robach for a new term on the Board of Review from January 1, 2011 to January 1, 2013. Motion carried.
7. Phil Keilman, Northern Michigan Sales/Marketing contacted us for 2010 dust control prices in 2011. Becker is investigating and will get back to the Board.
8. The Board looked over the Ottawa County Primary Road Program for 2011. Not much is happening in Wright Township.
9. Reports were given. A motion was made by Way and supported by Worrell to appoint Rick Schoenborn as 2<sup>nd</sup> Alternate for the Zoning Board of Appeals. The term will run from January 1, 2011 to January 1, 2014. Motion carried.

10. Supervisor reported that the sewer rates will be \$62 per month per REU which is a little lower than last year.

11. Dog licenses are now renewable when rabies shots are renewable payable to the County. Forms are available on-line at <http://www.miottawa.org/CoGov/Treasurer/> or at the township office.

A motion was made by Schoenborn and supported by Way to deny funds for Worrell to attend the MMTA conference because of limited resources. Four ayes, one abstains.

Motion carried.

The township will purchase new parcel maps for the entire township, with quarter sections for Sections 34 and 35. Worrell will check to see when new maps and splits will be published.

The Board reviewed the ordinance relative to liquor sales. Since it does not address Sunday sales, the board decided to take no action.

12. The meeting was adjourned at 9 p.m.
