

**WRIGHT TOWNSHIP
REGULAR BOARD MEETING
MARCH 10, 2010
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The following minutes were taken at the March, 2010 board meeting and are currently approved.

1. The Regular Board meeting was called to order by Supervisor Becker at 7:35 P.M. with the Pledge and a prayer. Board members present were JoAnn Becker, Tracy Worrell, Rick Schoenborn and Josh Westgate. A motion was made by Westgate and supported by Schoenborn to excuse the absence of Clerk Way. Motion carried.
2. The Wright/Tallmadge joint fire agreement will be added to the agenda as item #9.
3. A motion was made by Westgate and supported by Schoenborn to approve the bills in the amount of \$10,952.05 with corrections regarding board of review payments and to accept the Treasurer's report, Trust and Agency and Tax Account Profit & Loss. Motion carried. The budget was reviewed at the special board meeting prior to the regular board meeting. A motion was made by Worrell and supported by Becker to approve the minutes of the February 10 regular board meeting and February 18 special board meeting as written. Motion carried.
4. Kent Engle attended the meeting to introduce himself to the board as a candidate running for Ottawa County Circuit Court Judge in the November general election.
5. A motion was made by Schoenborn and supported by Worrell to ratify the appointment of Dan VanDyke (SE Quad) to the Planning Commission, Term 04/01/10-04/01/13. Motion carried.
6. The City of Coopersville, Chester Twp., Polkton Twp. and Wright Twp. millage supports social services and some recreational services for area seniors. Supervisor Becker reported that the recreational aspect of NOCCOA for these four municipalities is being split out and run locally. The City of Coopersville has agreed to administer the program. Each local jurisdiction providing millage funds for NOCCOA will assign a representative to serve on an advisory board. Supervisor Becker will represent Wright Township.
7. A motion was made by Schoenborn and supported by Westgate to accept the bid for dust control from MCS. (3 yes, 1 no) Motion carried.
8. A motion was made by Becker and supported by Schoenborn to approve the application for PA116 (farmland preservation) Timothy & Christine Kruithoff 70-06-04-200-009 & 017. Motion carried.

9. A motion was made by Worrell and supported by Westgate to accept as is the joint Wright/Tallmadge fire agreement renewal. Motion carried.

10. Reports were given.

11. Supervisor Becker presented information on a proposed celebration of Ed Cole, the developer of the Corvair, on September 18, 2010 at Cole Park in conjunction with the 50th Anniversary -Corvairs Cruise across America. Also presented were some estimates for new flooring and office furniture for the township offices. The project has been tabled for further discussion. The township extends a thank you to Gary Karr for installing much needed light fixtures in the office area.

12. The meeting was adjourned at 9:10 P.M.
