

WRIGHT TOWNSHIP REGULAR BOARD MEETING
October 13, 2010
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The following minutes were taken at the October, 2010 board meeting and APPROVED

1. The regular board meeting was called to order by Supervisor Becker at 7:30 P.M. with the Pledge and a prayer. Board members present were JoAnn Becker, Linda Way, Tracy Worrell and Josh Westgate. A motion was made by Way and supported by Westgate to excuse absence of Schoenborn while he is out of town.
 2. One addition to the agenda – Township Parcel Maps - #10.
 3. A motion was made by Westgate and supported by Worrell to approve the bills in the amount of \$16,597.50 and to accept the treasurer's report, Trust and Agency and Tax Account Profit & Loss. Motion carried. Worrell also distributed the Quarterly Statement, which includes P&L, sewer, Comstock Street and cemetery accounts. A motion was made by Westgate and supported by Becker to approve the minutes of September 8 Regular Board Meeting as written. Motion carried. *Attached*

 5. Way will contact contractors for cemetery and will look into records being updated.
 6. A motion was made by Way and supported by Becker to approve registration and mileage for the MTA Annual Educational Conference to be held in Grand Rapids at the end of January, 2011, Motion carried.
 7. Reports were given. Way commented on the "Silent Parade" – numerous fire trucks from all over Kent and Ottawa County (including Wright-Tallmadge) traveled down Alpine Avenue, through Westgate, down Lamoreaux and into Fifth-third Ball Park. Lights were flashing but sirens were off. Spectacular sight.
 8. Becker reported on EECSBG (grant) update, O. C. MTA Mtg., NE Quadrant Mtg., NOCCOA (Council on Aging) activities. The Council on Aging Reps will be at Wright Offs. Tues. Nov. 16 (1:30-3:30PM) to assist with Medicare Part D (Prescription) Open Enrollment - Walk-ins welcome.

9. Worrell requested administrative help on Fridays when she is in the office by herself. It will be tabled until November by which time duties of new employees will be determined. Worrell also discussed Michigan Municipal Treasurer's Association training in May.

10. Worrell discussed the possibility of purchasing 30" x 34" section maps at \$8 each. She will purchase one and we'll determine if they will be acceptable for what the township requires and what alterations we can request.
